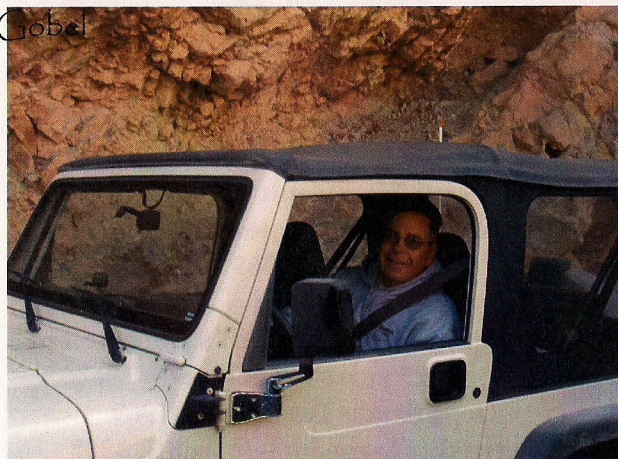


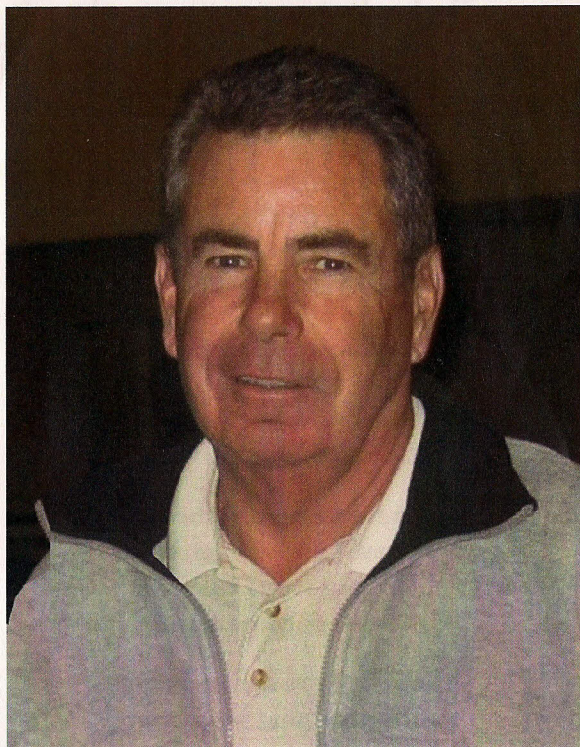

And whispered, "Come with me."

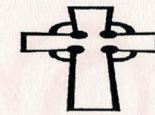
With tearful eyes, we watched you suffer
