Play

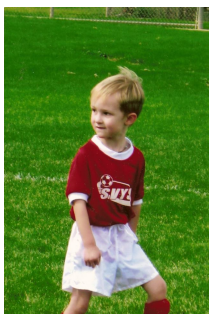

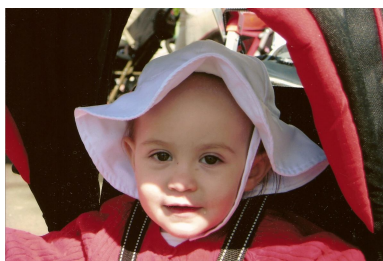

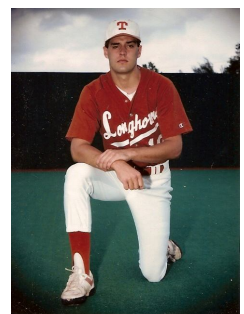
